FIRST CALL FOR PAPERS

Schedule

The Conference will convene on the Campus of the University of Arizona at 8 a.m. on the morning of Saturday, May 18th, 2002, and will conclude at noon on Tuesday, May 21st. Participants should therefore plan on arriving in Tucson on Friday, May 17th; registration will be from 5-8 p.m.

Conference sessions will be held on Saturday, Sunday, Monday (full days) and Tuesday morning. The Keynote Session: Culture Heritage Management in Africa: Present Status and Future Needs will be held on Tuesday morning and followed by the SAfA Business Meeting and the concluding address.

Organization

We invite submissions of individual papers or and thematic sessions. poster presentations Individual papers will be scheduled in sessions of two hours (five papers of twenty minutes, plus twenty minutes discussion); thematic sessions may run up to two and a half hours (maximum of six papers of twenty minutes plus thirty minutes discussion) .For individual papers or posters please submit proposed title of paper, name and affiliation of author(s) and a 100-word abstract. In the case of proposed thematic sessions, the session organizer must submit all contributions to the session as a single packet. If you have no access to email, submissions can be mailed to either organizer c/o Department of Anthropology, University of Arizona, Tucson, AZ 85721-0030, U.S.A. We would appreciate receipt of proposals for papers by September 15, 2001.

There will be a maximum of two parallel sessions (in adjacent lecture halls). We are therefore strongly encouraging the presentation of posters instead of papers and will be awarding prizes for the best professional and the best student poster contribution

35 mm Kodak Carousel slide projectors and overhead projectors will be available. Both lecture halls are also equipped with computers and digital projectors; participants who wish to make use of these should so indicate when submitting their abstracts.
